The *Air Force Families Forever Support Network* was created in September, 2010, as a means for families of fallen Airmen to connect with other families grieving the loss of their loved one, who died while serving in the U.S. Air Force. We believe the best way to cope with grief is receiving support from those who have suffered a similar loss.

Periodically, a list of new family members who have joined the *Air Force Families Forever Support Network* is emailed out to existing family members. This gives people the opportunity to look over the list and choose which family members they would like to connect with (sometimes by geographic region or relationship to the deceased).
